

LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ELECTION CANDIDATE SURVEY RESULTS

PLANNING MATTERS ALLIANCE TASMANIA (PMAT)

Legislative Council elections are being held on 4 May 2024 in the seats of Elwick, Hobart and Prosser. All 16 candidates across the three seats were contacted by email and invited to undertake the survey. Of these, 11 candidates completed the survey. The survey was open from Sunday 14 April 2024 until midnight Saturday 20 April 2024.

Three substantive questions (Questions 5, 6 and 7) were asked of candidates.
